Reference to Visit of Arthur Lagueux

Our meeting--a special one--was held on Thursday, Aug. 31, and was most successful; not so much from the standpoint of numbers, as that of interest. Our members were most happy to meet with the President of R.I. and his good wife, and there was good fellowship throughout the whole meeting.

So proud of the coming of the President of R.I. were we that we invited all the clubs in the Province of Alberta, but since Arthur was speaking in Calgary the day before, and anyone coming to Banff would have to pass through Calgary, it was to that place most of the clubs went. We had, however, four Rotarians from outside the Province with us. We further gave invitations to local groups such as Kinsmen, Junior Chamber of Commerce, and the Canadian Club, and from each one of these we had representation. All of these were much interested in Arthur's speech.

An interesting feature too of Arthur's visit was that a Foundation Fellowship Student was present. I met him the night previous, and while he was intending to go on to Calgary the next afternoon, he determined to stay over to have a chat with the President. The student's name, Mr. John Watson of New Zealand, on his way to Chapel Hill University, North Carolina.

The number of Rotarians present were 24 with their wives. Number of clubs represented were five. The total attendance would be 62.
