Lagueux to Pay Official
Visit to Local Club

All Clubs In District to Be
Represented

Arthur Lagueux, of Quebec City, president of Rotary International, will pay an official visit to the Savannah Rotary Club next Monday at 1 p. m. at the Hotel De Soto.

Mr. Lagueux will be introduced by Dr. Regnald Maxwell, retired Augusta dentist, who is governor of Rotary District 241, of which Savannah is a part. Every club in the District is sending a representative here for the luncheon meeting. Porter Carswell, of Waynesboro, an international director of Rotary, will be among the distinguished guests.

J. Phil Schenck, president of the local club, said President and Mrs. Lagueux will arrive in Savannah from Norfolk at 7:15 Sunday evening. They will depart by plane for St. Petersburg, Fla., Monday evening at the same time. Joseph Mendel and Hue Thomas, Jr., are general program chairman. Edwin B. McCuen, hospitality chairman, will assist Mr. and Mrs. Lagueux during their stay.

Mr. Lagueux is president of the investment corporation of Lagueux and DesRochers in Quebec City, Canada. He was born at Tring Junction, Quebec, and was educated at St. Anne-de-la-Pocatiere College (Quebec) and at St. Anne's Academy in New York City.

Mr. Lagueux is President of Rotary International for 1950-51. He has been a member of the Rotary Club of Quebec since 1934, is a past president of that club, and he has served Rotary International as director, district governor and as committee chairman and member.

Mr. Lagueux is president of the La Sarre Power Company in La Sarre, Quebec, and of the Financial Building in Quebec City. He is a director of the Commonwealth International Corporation and of the Leverage Fund of Canada, Ltd. In Quebec City, he is vice president of the Bond Dealers' Association and chairman of the Re-establishment Credit Advisory Committee of the Canadian Department of Veterans' Affairs. He is an officer of the Order of the British Empire.
